

CO-PARENTING CLASS FAST FACTS

This is a ONE TIME – TWO HOUR – INTERACTIVE Class online with the ZOOM virtual platform.

Target Audience:

- Parents with children of ALL AGES, infant to teen who are struggling with sharing parental roles with another adult. (spouse, parent, grandparent)
- Parents struggling with conflicting or different parenting strategies of another caregiver.
- Parents who are separated/divorced or co-parenting with stress.
- ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST attend the Positive Parenting Class prior to this class.

Objective:

- To examine the messages children receive from conflicting parenting styles and skills.
- To offer strategies in working with difficult or passive co-parents.
- To allow co-parents to come together in a therapeutic setting to discuss cooperation techniques.
- To learn strategies to manage a caregiver who will not attend or adjust their parenting style.

Where:

- This group is attended on ZOOM virtual meeting rooms.
- Participants will receive a link when they register that will take them directly to the meeting (or they use the included Meeting ID and enter it at <u>www.zoom.us/join)</u>
- Participants are required to have a camera and microphone on their phone/tablet/device.

When:

- This class meets ONE WEDNESDAY OF EACH MONTH from 6pm 8pm
- This class immediately follows the Positive Parenting so you can complete both in one night if you choose.
- Participants must register at ABChelps.com for this one time class.
